

Mission:Explore Competition Terms

1. The prize is a reward of £100 paid to your school, to be used towards developing your solution. A total of 4 prizes are available.
2. The Competition is open to students at school in the UK (England, Scotland, Wales or Northern Ireland) aged between 7-16 (inclusive), except employees of The Geography Collective, The Workshop (Sheffield) Limited, Ordnance Survey, their families, or anyone connected with the Competition in another way. You can also enter the Competition as a class group.
3. To enter, you must:
 - be a registered member of [Mission:Explore](#);
 - win the [GeoVation Food Badge](#) on Mission:Explore by completing all 3 missions;
 - come up with a solution to a problem to do with food. This can be to do with sustainability, growing food, waste, healthy living, or something else.
 - use Ordnance Survey mapping for your solution in some way. A great way is to create a map using OS OpenSpace, or the Digimap for Schools service.
 - complete the entry form (which we will email to you on winning the GeoVation Food Badge) with details including your name (or the name of your class entry group), school name, school address and your email address (or, if you are under 13, the email address of your teacher, parent or guardian).
4. When you complete the entry form, you will need to agree that Mission:Explore can provide your entries and personal information to Ordnance Survey for administering the competition. Ordnance Survey will not use the information for anything else.
5. You may only enter once. The Opening Date for entries is 09:00 on 14 January 2012. The Closing Date for entries is 23:59 on 14 June 2012.
6. Mission:Explore and GeoVation will judge your entry by looking at the following:
 - **Problem:** We want to see that you understand the problem that you are tackling. Show us that you understand the causes of the problem.
 - **Solution:** GeoVation is all about innovation and creativity. We will be looking to award prizes to solutions that do something different and better than is currently happening. This can either be how the problem is solved or a way of presenting a current solution. Make sure you tell us how your idea is innovative.
 - **Execution:** We want to see a simple plan of how you are going to turn your solution into results that directly address your problem. Show us that you understand that you need a budget, a timeline and the steps you are going to take.
 - GeoVation and Mission:Explore will choose the entries that are most innovative but also most likely to be successful.
 - We will take your age into account when making our decision, and look at whether you have entered on your own or in a class group.

7. Winners will be announced on 1 July 2012. If you have won, we will send an email to the address you have provided before this date.
8. We may reduce the number and amount of prizes if we don't receive enough good entries to run the competition fairly.
9. We will pay the Prize by cheque, made out to your school, within 10 days of the Closing Date.
10. If you win, we will ask you to report on how you are using the Prize to develop your solution. All winners will be required to submit at least one interim blog post on the GeoVation website to share your progress. At the end of the project winners are required to submit a one page report on how the project has gone including your project aim(s), outcomes and lessons learnt.
11. If you win, Mission:Explore and Ordnance Survey may publish your name and the name of your school on their websites.
